White Wines

1. Emiliana Sauvignon Blanc – Central Valley, Chile £11.95
175ml £3.25 250ml £4.25

Aromatic dry white with a herbaceous, grassy bouquet, intense melon, apricot and citrus flavours and well balanced racy acidity.

2. Pinot Grigio Ancora – Lombardy, Italy £14.95
175ml £3.65 250ml £4.95

Italy's most fashionable white, this is a nicely rounded easy-drinking style which is softly perfumed with delicate, fresh citrus fruit flavours.

3. The Last Stand Chardonnay – Cowra, Australia £15.50

Full bodied white with lush tropical pineapple, peach and lemon fruits combined with light toasty vanilla oak undertones.

4. Slowine Chenin Sauvignon – Stellenbosch, South Africa
£13.50

Beautiful aromas of guava, gooseberry and ripe tropical fruit tantalize the nose and follow through to a balanced mouthful that's supple and refreshing.

5. Chablis La Colombe – Burgundy, France £19.95

A text-book example of a French classic, lean and minerally with a buttery finish.

6. 3 Stones Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, New Zealand
£17.50

A stunning example of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc. Pure, crisp, herbaceous aromas and a zesty passion fruit style palate.

7. Sacred Hill Traminer Riesling – South East Australia
£13.50

The fragrant Traminer grape blends well with the fresh, fruity Riesling to produce an easy-drinking, medium wine.

Red Wines

8. Emiliana Merlot – Central Valley, Chile £11.95
175ml £3.25 250ml £4.25

Silky smooth and packed full of soft, juicy plum and blackcurrant fruit flavours.

9. Mirador Tinto – Rioja, Spain £14.95
175ml £3.65 250ml £4.95

Just what we look for in a good red Rioja, soft damson fruits and a soft oak finish.

10. Willowglen Shiraz Cabernet – South East Australia £13.50

Easy drinking wine full of blackberry and plum fruits with a tantalising hint of spice.

11. Clos Malverne Pinotage – Stellenbosch, South Africa £17.95

This is a powerful, full-bodied red, with a strong medicinal aroma of cloves and vanilla. The palate is a forceful combination of ripe plum and chocolate tones, firm tannins and well balanced acidity.

12. Crozes Hermitage Cave de Tain – Rhone, France £19.95

The Syrah grape is king in the vineyards of the northern Rhone and at Cave de Tain its full-bodied blackberry spice and damson qualities are shown off to the full.

13. Paarl Heights Shiraz – Paarl, South Africa £14.95

A fresh medium-bodied red with ripe, plummy aromas and rich, lightly spiced fruit on the palate.

14. Villa la Pagliaia Chianti Classico – Tuscany, Italy £17.95

Lovely perfumed blueberry and cherry fruit, interwoven with rich spices and liquorice. A tightly knit palate with supple tannins and a pleasant savoury character integrated into the fruit and spice.

Rose Wines

15. Discovery Beach White Zinfandel – California, U.S.A £11.95
175ml £3.25 250ml £4.25

Medium-dry rosé with plenty of soft summer strawberry fruit flavours.

16. Pinot Grigio Rose Ancora – Lombardy, Italy £14.95
175ml £3.65 250ml £4.95

A classic Italian wine with a twist of pink!. Fresh, dry and crammed with summer fruit flavours.

Sparkling Wines

17. Vetricano Prosecco – Veneto, Italy £17.95

Fresh and fruity with a soft, creamy mousse, a very easy drinking glass of Italy's favourite fizz.

18. JP Robert NV Brut – Champagne £30.00

Our "House" Champagne is a very well-made combination of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes, giving a fresh palate with a fine biscuity character.
